Start these instructions 7 days prior to your procedure:

- O No contact lens wearing
- O Fill the **YELLOW** and **BLUE** eye drop prescriptions you have been given. Follow instructions listed on them.
- O Use non-preservative artificial tears (individual vials)

 ONE drop, per eye, 4 times daily starting on the date listed above and continue until procedure. (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner, and Bedtime)

NO BOTTLED TEARS!! Approved list: Refresh, Refresh Plus, Refresh Optive, Systane Ultra, or Theratears.

DO NOT use Refresh Optive ADVANCED, Refresh Optive Mega-3, or ANY bottled tears!

- O Take oral Flax Seed Oil capsules (1000mg) twice daily starting on the date listed above. Oral Flax Seed Oil capsules are available over the counter. (Walmart, Target, CVS, Walgreens, etc.)
- O Take Vitamin C (500mg) once daily starting on the date listed above and continue for 6 months after surgery.
- APPLY FOR FINANCING <u>prior</u> to surgery day.
 DO NOT wait until surgery day!

THE DAY BEFORE your procedure:

- O Begin **ONLY** the antibiotic drop (Zymaxid,Vigamox, Moxifloxacin or Gatifloxacin) **ONE** drop, per eye, 4 times daily the day **BEFORE** surgery. (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner, and Bedtime). Steroid drop (FML, Fluorometholone, Pred Mild, Flarex, or Alrex) will begin **AFTER** surgery
- O Continue using artificial tears.
- O Read your consent forms.
- O Contact your bank to remove fraud alerts. Your card will decline for any charge over \$1500.
- O Clean eyelids/eyelashes the night before your surgery using one of your eyelid scrubs. No make-up once starting lid scrub.
- O Take one 800mg Motrin from the enclosed envelope or 4 200mg pills of Advil, Mortin, or Ibuprofen you have on hand.

ON THE DAY of your procedure BEFORE YOU LEAVE HOME:

- O Eat a light meal before the procedure.
- O Continue taking all of your regular medications unless specifically instructed otherwise.
- O Clean eyelids/eyelashes thoroughly using one of your lid scrubs.
- O Do not wear makeup, moisturizers, perfume/cologne.
- O Take 800mg Motrin.
- O Do not use antibiotic drop prior to arrival.
- O Continue using tears.
- O Wear comfortable clothing and low heeled shoes. No fuzzy fleeces, sweaters, or anything that sheds fibers. Preferably no pullover sweatshirts.
- O Expect to be at our office for two to three hours.

- O Driver
